



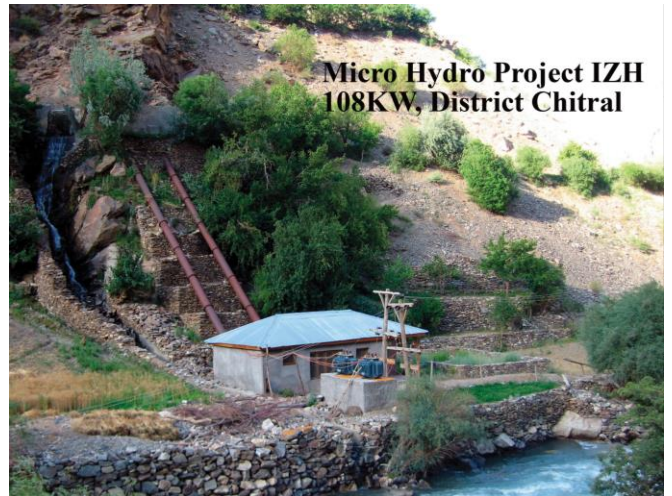
PPAF Wins International Prestigious Energy Institute Award 2016

PPAF has won Energy Institute (EI) award 2016 for Community Managed Hydropower Project. The EI Awards is an annual competition run by the Energy Institute (UK), a professional body for the energy industry developing and sharing knowledge, skills and good practice towards a safe, secure and sustainable energy system. The purpose of awards is to celebrate the outstanding achievements in the energy sector by both individuals and organizations.

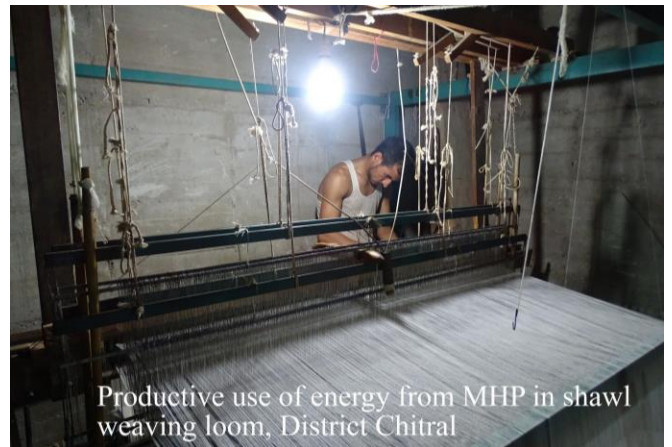
The EI Awards recognize those in the industry who have demonstrated excellence and innovation in their daily work, and thus made an invaluable contribution to shaping our energy future.

PPAF's nominated project is about 55 Micro Hydels providing 15 MW of clean energy to 12,000 households in 80 villages in the remote north. Besides lighting homes the Project has also created much needed economic opportunities for enterprise development.

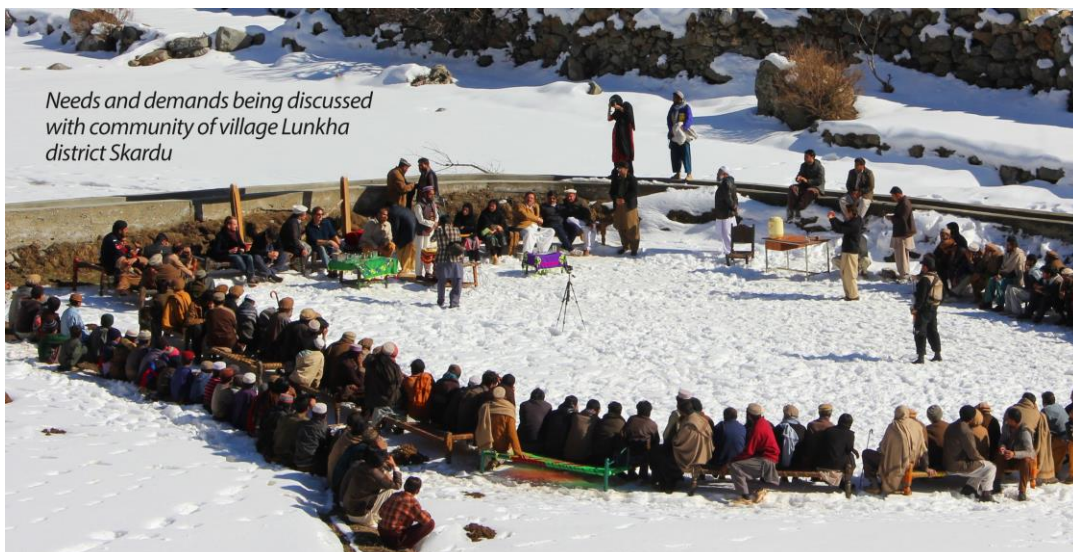
