The organisation is accepting applications and inviting students and fresh graduates to explore the work dynamics of the development sector.

What's the programme like? Spanning over two weeks (July 8 till July 19, 2019), this internship programme is primarily an exposure based opportunity, allowing you to explore possible career choices in the development sector by getting first-hand knowledge about PPAF and its interventions.

This internship will be a mix of class room learning along with field exposure in a secure rural or semi-urban area where PPAF will take care of travel and accommodation. Field travel is an integral part of the programme.

Our expectations? You will be expected to adhere to the rules and regulations provided on PPAF website. You will also be expected to provide at least one case study - your findings from the field and make a presentation.

Costs? Field related transportation, meals and other expenses will be borne by PPAF. The interns will be expected to make their own living arrangements in Islamabad. However; interns may be facilitated for twin sharing Boarding & Lodging on request only.
