## LHC issues non-bailable arrest warrant for Moonis Elahi's wife

LAHORE, (NNI): The Lahore High Court (LHC) on Monday issued a non-bailable arrest warrant for Tehreem Elahi, wife of Pakistan Tehreek-e-Insaf (PTI) leader Moonis Elahi's wife.

As per details, a two-member bench headed by LHC Judge Justice Shahram Sarwar Chaudhary heard the plea seeking cancellation of the Raikhi Elahi, Tehreem Elahi and others bail.

At the outset of the hearing, the High Court issued

a non-bailable arrest warrant for Moonis Elahi's wife Tehreem in the FIA money laundering case.

Earlier, a special court declared Pakistan Tehreek-e-Insaf (PTI) leader Moonis Elahi a money laundering case.

Over continued absence from the court, the special court judge issued a permanent arrest warrant for the son of former Punjab CM.

On the other side, the Special Central Court in Lahore ordered to release

of all assets and bank accounts of former federal minister Moonis Elahi - son of PTI President Parvez Elahi - in a money laundering case on November 17.

The court has demanded a comprehensive report on the freezing of accounts and assets to be presented at the next hearing.

The court expressed satisfaction with the report that the former minister is deliberately evading the arrest while seeking assistance from the relevant institution in the case.

## SSGC seeks OGRA's nod for another gas tariff hike

ISLAMABAD, (NNI): The Sui Southern Gas Company (SSGC) has moved the Oil and Gas Regulatory Authority (OGRA) for another gas tariff hike, effective from July 1, 2024.

According to the proposal, SSGC has urged the OGRA to hike up gas prices by Rs324 per million British thermal units (mmbtu), aiming to set a new average price of Rs1740.80 per mmbtu.

OGRA is scheduled to conduct hearings on SSGC's petition, with sessions slated for today in Karachi and March 20 in Quetta.

This follows a series of previous increases in gas prices throughout the current fiscal year.

It is to be noted that Pakistan's economic team negotiating with the International Monetary Fund (IMF) team on the second review under SBA for the release of \$1.1 bn, 'assured' the international leader of further jacking up the gas and electricity prices.

Earlier, the Sui Southern Gas Company (SSGC) said that Pakistan's gas reserves are likely to be reduced by half by 2027.

The Sui Southern Gas Company (SSGC) said the consumption of the gas is increasing and the reserves of the natural gas are diminishing rapidly.

The company underlined the need to shift to RLNG from the local gas.

## High level Iranian delegation to visit Pakistan in April

ISLAMABAD, (NNI): Preparations are underway for the visit of a high-level Iranian delegation to Pakistan in April, citing diplomatic sources.

Sources said that the Iranian delegation will comprise of 20 to 25 officials and two to three senior ministers.

"Two sides working over the high-level Iranian delegation's visit to Pakistan",

"The delegation from Iran is expected to attend inauguration of the Pakistan chapter of the Iran-Pakistan Gas Pipeline," sources said.

The delegation also expected to sign scores of memoranda of understanding (MoUs) with regard to bilateral trade, energy, security, investment and defence, sources said.

Iranian President Ebrahim Raisi is also expected to visit Pakistan this year.

According to diplomatic sources, Pakistan and Iran free trade agreement has been expected during the visit of President Ebrahim Raisi.

The free trade agreement between the two countries could manifest enhancement in volume of mutual trade, sources said.

Iranian President will hold meetings with Pakistan's political and military leadership during his visit.

The officials of Pakistan and Iran are working over mutual agreements with regard to the visit. The countries will give preferential tariff and other concessions to their products, diplomatic sources said.

An inter-ministerial session will be held in Pakistan before the visit.

## Gen (R) Faiz Hameed's brother arrested in corruption case

RAWALPINDI, (NNI): Anti-Corruption Circle Rawalpindi has arrested former Naib Tehsildar Chakwal Najaf Hameed after the cancellation of his bail in corruption case.

Former tehsildar Najaf Hameed has been arrested from the premises of the Anti-Corruption Court.

Najaf Hameed, the brother of former ISI chief Faiz Hameed, was arrested on Monday by the anti-corruption department's Rawalpindi circle after his bail application was dismissed by Judge Ali Nawaz Bhakar in a case of corruption and bribery.

According to sources, the officials of the anti-corruption

department arrested Najaf Hameed and left for Chakwal on court orders.

Reportedly, 18 suspects were booked in a case of bribery, misuse of authority and losses to the national exchequer. However, the remaining suspects are still at large.

Najaf was later once again presented before Judge Ali Nawaz Bhakar of the Anti-Corruption Special Court. The court dismissed his pre-arrest bail application.

Najaf then decided to approach the senior civil judge (criminal) for pre-arrest bail. He will be presented before the court of the senior civil judge along with his lawyers in the custody of anti-corruption officials.

As per reports, Najaf Hameed had secured protective bail from the court in the bribery case. In April 2023, the Anti-Corruption Establishment (ACE) had initiated an inquiry against him on allegations of out-of-turn promotion and accumulating assets beyond means.

The anti-graft body wrote a letter to the deputy commissioners of Rawalpindi and Chakwal asking for the record of land owned by Najaf Hameed. On February 13, he was suspended from the post of naib tehsildar in Chakwal over alleged misconduct.

## MNA Sher Afzal Marwat records his statement before FIA team

ISLAMABAD, (NNI): Newly elected PTI/SIC MNA Sher Afzal Marwat again said on Monday that if anything had happened to him, PML-N would be responsible for that.

Talking to the media outside the Federal Investigation Agency's (FIA) office in Islamabad, he, however, said he could not be cowed by threats to his life.

He further said 15 years ago a man fled to Dubai from Pakistan. "As far my information is concerned, some people from India contacted him when the Punjab Chief Minister asked them to do so to plan my murder," he said, adding, "I have audio messages which are both in Urdu and Pashto."

He said there was a need to investigate these audio messages.

Marwat said that politics in Pakistan had become dirty after May 9. "Anybody can be kidnapped or murdered," he said, and added, "Those in the PML-N are so powerful that they don't want to see anybody raising voice against them."

The PTI stalwart said that the party's mandate was stolen. "Regime change by the US has plunged the country into complete chaos."

He went on to say that the nation by voting for the PFI-backed independent candidates in the February 8 elections had rejected the narrative built around May 9 incidents of violence.

Earlier, a three-member inquiry committee of the FIA's Cyber Crime Wing, headed by an additional director, put questions to Marwat in connection with

his allegations against the Punjab CM which he had made on social media site X on March 9.

The FIA team also asked Marwat to give his cell phone to them so that they could investigate his claims by listening to audio messages.

In one of his tweets, Marwat claimed to be the target of a plot orchestrated by the Punjab Chief Minister, stating, "It is imperative to publicly acknowledge that 'Maryam Nawaz Sharif' poses a threat to my life, as she has orchestrated an assassination attempt against me, which can take place at any time."

He further alleged, "An amount of \$100,000 has been allocated by Maryam Nawaz Sharif to these assassins for the execution of my murder."

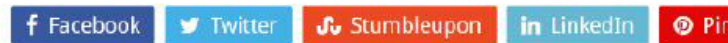

The program has had a positive impact on the lives of beneficiary communities, improving their quality of life, increasing economic activity and reducing the environmental impact.

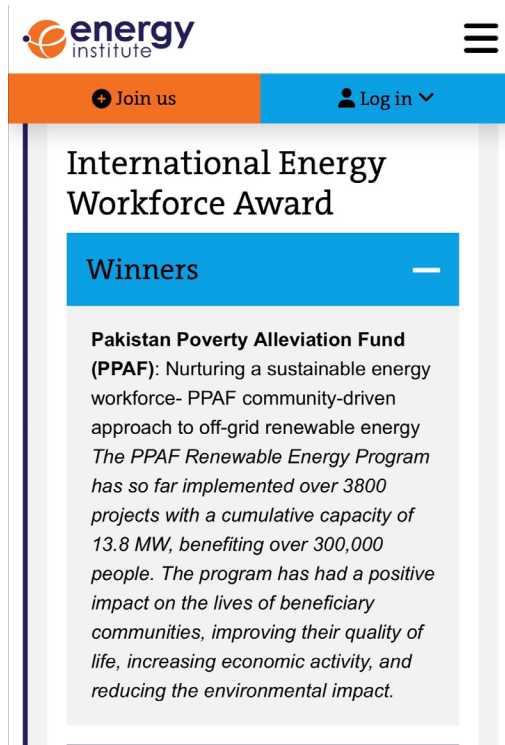
