QUETTA: Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of Pakistan Poverty Alleviation Fund (PPAF), Nadir Gul Bareach has said that in response to the destructive floods that have wreaked havoc in Gwadar district, PPAF is actively helping the flood victims.

He expressed these views while talking to the media representatives during distribution of relief aid to flood victims. He said that the Pakistan Poverty Alleviation Fund (PPAF) has swiftly launched an emergency relief operation to extend vital assistance to affected communities.

Heavy rainfall in February 2024 led to widespread devastation, with homes submerged, infrastructure damaged, and lives disrupted, he said. He said that responding to the urgent need for aid, PPAF mobilized its resources to offer immediate relief to those affected by the calamity.

Collaborating with Strengthening Participatory Organization (SPO), PPAF devised a comprehensive strategy under the banner of the "Emergency Relief Assistance to 2024 Flood-Affected Communities in Gwadar" project, he mentioned. He said that central to this effort was the procurement and distribution of essential relief items, meticulously curated to meet the immediate needs of flood-affected households. The relief packages, funded by PPAF and implemented by SPO, comprised both food and non-food items tailored to provide sustenance, hygiene, and comfort to those in distress. Among the items distributed were rice, lentils, flour, salt, sugar, tea, milk powder, household items and hygiene kits.

It is our misfortune that the whole nation is divided on terrorism in Balochistan. Our most important document is the Constitution of Pakistan and after that there is National Action Plan and other important documents.

In the NAP, the violence in Balochistan has been separated that it is another type of violence, this is a big question mark for the Pakistani nation to think that the parliament is thinking that violence is the same as we have been doing before the good and bad Taliban.

It is said that if it is permissible to kill soldiers, FC, Levies, this minister remains, how will we address the problem, saying that everything is fine in Balochistan, everything is not fine in Balochistan, there is insurgency in Balochistan. Three fronts have been opened against us, one gun sometimes strikes, sometimes succeeds, sometimes fails, the other front is a narrative that one should accept and one should not.

A protest was talked about in the National Assembly, it was talked about in the Provincial Assembly, these are the voices of targeting the state, targeting the state institutions, missing persons being a problem, there the voice becomes very loud, here your voice is silent or you would have condemned the violence.

The permission of violence lies with the state. We say that by creating an atmosphere on one side of the incident, voices are raised against the state. He said that Punjab spends one billion rupees to educate the children of Balochistan.


