

<h4>SCALE</h4> <p>Outreach in 33 districts through 35 Partner Organisations.</p> 	<h4>LOCALISING DEVELOPMENT</h4> <p>298,800 households organised, fostering social capital through a grassroots network of 21,300 Community Institutions.</p> 	<h4>FINANCIAL SUPPORT</h4> <p>46,200 interest free loans disbursed under the Prime Minister's Interest Free Loan Programme (32% loans to women).</p> 	<h4>CAPACITY BUILDING</h4> <p>93,600 individuals (34% women) received enterprise and skills training.</p> 	<h4>EDUCATIONAL SUPPORT</h4> <p>127,900 students (40% girls) enrolled in 900 educational facilities.</p> 	<h4>PROMOTING INTERFAITH HARMONY</h4> <p>1,170 Madrassah Students (35% girls) received academic support, 26 teachers trained, & 20 religious places renovated to promote interfaith harmony.</p>
